Subject: Directions to provide updated information for Third Party Transparency Audit of Lok Nayak Hospital website for the year 2024-25.

In compliance of the judgment of the Supreme Court of India dated 17th August, 2023, in the matter of Kishan Chand Jain Vs Union of India and others, WP(C) 990/2021, Third Party Transparency Audit exercise for the year 2024-25 has been started on the Central Information Commission's portal under its direct and continuous monitoring.

The Third party Transparency Audit entails the audit of the proactive suo-motu disclosure u/s 4 of the RTI Act 2005 done on the website of Lok Nayak Hospital (Public Authority) in terms of the following:

- 3. Transfer policy and transfer orders

For the sake of clarity, the section/branch responsible for disclosing the information has been mentioned against the relevant point in the framework.

All branch In-Charges/HODs are hereby directed to provide the relevant updated information pertaining to their branch/section/department as detailed in the framework enclosed, to the RTI Cell, for updating on the website of Lok Nayak Hospital. In case no update is needed in any branch/section/department, the concerned In-Charge/HOD may record a certificate regarding the same and submit it to the RTI Cell. This exercise should be done on priority.

Further, in order to maintain an updated website with respect to suo-motu disclosure, henceforth a copy of all orders/instructions in relation to the matters mentioned at points 1-8 above may be endorsed to the Public Information Officer (PIO), Lok Nayak Hospital for information.
