Note :-

- (1) This certificate should be issued only to those Orthopaedically Handicapped/Paraplegic persons/
patients WHO CAN NOT TRAVEL WITHOUT THE ASSISTANCE OF AN ESCORT. The
photo must be signed and stamped in such a way that Doctor's signature and stamp appears
partly on the photo and partly on the certificate.
- (2) In the case of temporary disability, the certificate will be valid for five years from the date of issue.
In the case of permanent disability, the certificate will remain valid for (1) five years, in case of
persons up to the age of 25 years, (2) ten years, in case of persons in the age group of 26 to 35
years and (3) in the case of persons above the age of 35 years, the certificate will remain valid for
whole life of the concerned person. After expiry of the period of validity of the certificate, the
person is required to obtain a fresh certificate. A Photostat copy of this certificate is accepted for
the purpose of grant of concession. The original certificate will have to be produced for inspection
at the time of purchase of concessional ticket and during the journey, if demanded.
- (3) No alteration in the form is permitted.
