
Introduction:

Services offered and Departmental Achievements

Treatment Services:

Department has fully equipped outpatient department which offers treatment services in the field of Dermatology, STD and Leprosy.

- Separate outpatient clinics function daily for Skin patients which caters to an average 1000-1500 patients per day.
- Cases of leprosy and STD are also seen daily.
- Minor OT services are also available daily, which include electric & chemical cautery, intralesional injections and skin biopsy etc.
 The department has in patient care facilities.
- Two wards (separate for males, females and children) with a total strength of 41 beds exist.
- It also runs a full- fledged operational theatre twice a week where in different minor and major dermatological surgeries (including mini punch grafting for vitiligo, excision of growths, nerve biopsies, nail surgeries, cryosurgery etc.) are being carried out, PRP, Botulinum for hyperhydrosis

Post Graduate Training Programme

- 1. Post Graduation (Degree & Diploma) in the specialty of Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy is offered.
- 2. Duration: 3 yrs (Degree), 2 yrs Diploma
- 3. Eligibility: M.B.B.S. $(4\frac{1}{2} \text{ Years}) + 1 \text{ Year internship.}$
- 4. Selection: Entrance examination conducted by the Delhi University
- 5. No. of Seats: 3 MD & 1 DVD Per Year.
- 6. Session starts in the month of June July

Senior Residency Programme:

The department also offers a teaching and research oriented 3 years Senior Residency Programme to the residents with postgraduate qualification in specialty. Selection is through application and interview.
