1. All Provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 and Rules made there under as amended till date will always be applicable. 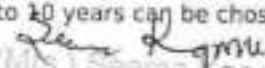
The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. 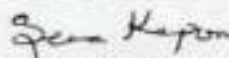

13. The system should be CE/FDA approved for Hemoglobinopathies and Thalassemia screening.
14. The system has LIS facility and enables to take the patient reports in PDF format.
15. Satisfactory performance form or certificate from End user, that too from atleast 3 government hospitals or institutions.
16. Onboard system memory should be for atleast 10,000 cases/samples/runs with provision for atleast 2 backup drives of 2TB each to be supplied with each instrument.
17. 2KVA UPS offline should be supplied with each equipment.
18. Indicative test number will be 10,000/ test per annum per machine which may vary.

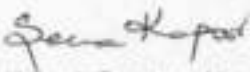

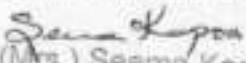

9. The Break off Valve should be present in the donor line to avoid contamination of the donor line with the first volume of contaminated blood and to avoid mixing of the anticoagulant solution with the first volume of collected blood.
10. Different color-coded clamps should be provided on donor tube and sampling line for easy identification and to avoid confusion for blood collection staff.
11. Labels should be clear, legible, non-peel able meeting all requirements of ISO 3826 standards. Security cut should be present in the labels to make it tamper proof. The Labels should be tamper evident that is any attempt to peel off the label shall result in the label being destroyed. Pharmacopoeia reference should be mentioned on the blood bag label. Labels should be barcoded as per ISB T-128.
12. Each unit should be packed in an individual primary packing made of Polyethylene Terephthalate Cast Polypropylene (PET-CPP) to ensure sufficient barrier properties and sterility of the bags. The blood bags should be terminally sterilized along with the primary packing using moist heat sterilization.
13. The entire bag should be a closed system such that the sterility of the system is not compromised even after opening the foil covers. GS1 (GTIN) barcode should be provided on unit packing and shipping cartons as per MOH guidelines. The Expiry Date for blood bags should not be more than 24 months from the Date of Manufacture. The shelf life of the bags at the time of delivery should more than 75% of the total shelf life.
14. The integrated filter for leukocyte depletion of red blood cells must be stable with component of core temperature in the range of 4°C to room temperature. Filtration of red blood cells must be completed for >95% of bags within 120 minutes from the time at which the flow of the blood into the filter is opened.
15. The bags should have eyelets and slits compatible with all major automated component separators. Top and Bottom Blood bag with integral leukocyte filter for red blood cells should comply to all requirements of ISO 3826 standard for blood bags.
16. Should comply to all requirements of AABB and Council of Europe Guidelines for Leuco depleted Red Blood Cells and blood components. Minimum Market standing in India of more than 5 years for Top and Bottom Filter Inline bag.
17. Technical qualification should only be completed as a part of the technical bid demonstration of inline filter bags.
