Qualification:

- (1) Medical Officer: (I) A recognized MBBS qualification included in the First and Second Scheduled or Part-II of the Third Schedule (other than licentiate qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956. Holders of Education qualification included in Part-II of the Third Schedule should also fulfill the conditions stipulated in sub section (3) of section (13) of the Indian Medical Council Act. 1956.
- (2) Post-Graduate degree / Diploma in the concerned super speciality mentioned in Section-A of Schedule-VI or equivalent.
- (3) Three Year's experience in the concerned Super-Speciality after obtaining the first Post-Graduate degree or 05 years experience after obtaining the PG Diploma.
- Note: (1) In the case of holders DM/DNB (Medical Genetics) qualifications, shall be counted towards requirement of experience. Experience in genetic counselling and handling patients with thalassemia and rare blood disorders over a period of 2 years or longer

- (1) For retired personnel up to the age 65 years.
- (2) For fresh candidates not exceeding 50 years.

Note: The age will be reckoning from the date of notification of vacancies.

Pay:-

- (1) In case of retired personnel are selected as consultant against the vacant post of Non-Teaching Specialist, the pay will be regulated based on the formula:- i.e. Pay Last Pay drawn (at the time of retirement) Less Pension.
- (2) In case of fresh candidate is selected the pay will be initial Basic Pay in r/o Non Teaching Specialist Grade III i.e. Minimum of Pay Level 10 of Matrix 56100-177500 as per 7th CPC, (pre-revised Rs.15600-39100+5400 Grade Pay as per 6th CPC) plus usual allowance as applicable including NPA.

Eligible and desirous candidates shall submit duly filled application form with one set of attested photocopies of education qualification and experience in the office of the AMS (A), LNH.
