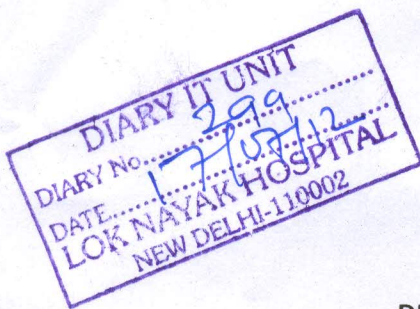

This issue as per the guidelines issued by the Director (Directorate of Health Services) vide letter no. F.25 (III)/DGEHS/111/DHS/2005/06/10248-288 dated 12-03-2008. and F. No. 25(III)/DGEHS/243/DHS/2011-12/10865-96 dated 24-02-2012, Karkardooma, Delhi and also as per the directions issued by the Audit department vide their letter H.M No.-14 dt. 19/5/2011 and H.M. No.26 dated 20-06-2012.

So all the prescribing doctors are advised to write the prescription with **GENERIC NAMES** only.
